Duties & Responsibilities:

- Handing out Festival programs at the main entrance
- Monitoring back gate access

- Be able to work in a fast-paced environment
- Must be at least 19 years of age to work in bar area
- Often requires you to stand on your feet for long periods of time
- Confident dealing with the general public – effective communication skills
- Clean, casual-business dress with comfortable footwear

All Outside Site Crew will be provided direction from, and supervised by, the Crew Leader. Any questions or comments about the position should be directed to him/her.

Orientation:

Prior to the festival, all Outside Site Crew will meet to confirm specific duties, arrange time/shift commitments and answer any questions volunteers have.
